

**WE WILL REMEMBER THEM. WOODBOROUGH ROAD BAPTIST CHURCH WAR MEMORIAL.**

**Major Leslie C Woodward DSO.** Royal Field Artillery. Died 3<sup>rd</sup> September 1918. Buried in Heilly Station Cemetery, France. Husband of Annie of 4 Baker Street, Nottingham.

**Second Lieutenant Charles E Ferguson.** Royal Flying Corps. Died 18th October 1917. Buried in Sanctuary Wood cemetery, Belgium. Son of George and Harriet of 20 Villa Road, Nottingham.

**Lieutenant Arthur Cyril Frettingham.** Welsh Regiment. Died 27<sup>th</sup> February 1917. Buried in Nottingham Church Cemetery, UK. Son of Charles and Mary of The Orchard, Attenborough, Nottingham.

**Second Lieutenant Herbert D Scanlon.** Australian Imperial Force. Died 5<sup>th</sup> August 1916. Buried in Pozieres Cemetery, Somme, France. Originally from West Bridgford, Nottingham.

**Lieutenant Herbert Wade MC.** Machine Gun Corps. Died 2<sup>nd</sup> November 1918. Buried in Vendegies Au Bois British Cemetery, France. Son of Charles of Linwood House, Mount Hooton Road, Nottingham.

**Second Lieutenant Sidney Wade.** Lincolnshire Regiment. Died 26<sup>th</sup> October 1918. Buried in Nottingham General Cemetery. Brother of the above.

**Private Leonard Adamson.** Royal Field Artillery. Died 7<sup>th</sup> June 1918. Buried in Houchin British Cemetery, France. Husband of Roslina of 11 Mansfield Grove, Nottingham.

**Private Frederick Atkinson.** York & Lancaster Regiment. Died 15<sup>th</sup> October 1918. Buried in Mikra British Cemetery, Kalamaria, Greece. Son of Fanny of Woodborough Road, Nottingham.

**Private William Henry Atkinson.** Kings Own Yorkshire Light Infantry. Died 27<sup>th</sup> July 1918. Buried in Terlincthun British Cemetery, France. Husband of Gertrude of 114 Bunbury Street, Nottingham.

**Private Ernest Elvey.** Sherwood Foresters. Died 13<sup>th</sup> October 1918. Buried in Montay Neuilly Road Cemetery, France. Son of Thomas and Eunice of Denman Street, Radford, Nottingham.

**Air Mechanic John William Green.** Royal Naval Air Service. Died 6<sup>th</sup> August 1917. Buried in Nottingham General Cemetery, Nottingham. Husband of Elsie of 47 Stratford Road, West Bridgford, Nottingham. Funeral was at Woodborough Road Baptist Church.

**Private Edward Owen Grocock.** Sherwood Foresters. Died 1<sup>st</sup> July 1917. Remembered on the Arras Memorial, France. Son of Edward and Edith of 1 Chaucer Terrace, Nottingham.

**Corporal Henry Hellas Haynes.** Loyal North Lancashire Regiment. Died 17<sup>th</sup> June 1917. Buried in Vlamertinghe New Military Cemetery, Belgium. Husband of Edith of 121 Forest Road, Nottingham. His father was a Baptist Minister – Reverend William Haynes.

**Private William Ernest Horner.** Sherwood Foresters. Died 13<sup>th</sup> March 1917. Buried in Warlincourt Halte British Cemetery, France. Son of Joshua and Eunice Horner of 12 Ebers Road, Mapperley Park, Nottingham.

**Private Samuel Hufton.** Army Service Corps. Died 4<sup>th</sup> July 1918. Buried in Lembet Road Military Cemetery, Salonica. Husband of Harriett of 43 Conway street, Nottingham.

**Private Clarence Minard.** Sherwood Foresters. Died 25<sup>th</sup> August 1917. Buried in Empleux Le Guerard British Cemetery, France. Son of Reuben and Emily of Alfred Street, Nottingham.

**Corporal Arthur Parnham.** Machine Gun Corps. Died 1<sup>st</sup> August 1917. Remembered on the Menin Gate, Ypres, Belgium. Son of William and Mary of 23 Egerton Street, St Ann's Well Road, Nottingham.

**Private Frederick William Rowland.** Durham Light Infantry. Died between June and September 1918. Buried in Sissonne British Cemetery, France. Son of John and Eliza of 107 Woodborough Road, Nottingham.

**Sapper Joseph Rowland.** Royal Engineers. Died 2<sup>nd</sup> November 1917. Buried in Gaza war Cemetery, Palestine. Son of John and Eliza and brother of Frederick above.

**Private Gilbert Straw.** Royal Army Medical Corps. Died 14<sup>th</sup> November 1918. Remembered on the Tehran Memorial, Iran. Son of John and Agnes of 24 Ena Avenue, Sneinton, Nottingham.
