

21 March 1918

After declaring war on Germany in April 1917, American troops finally start arriving 12 months later to support the British and French





October The Italians defeat the Austrians at the Battle of Vittorio Veneto (mmm, sounds like












Bad news for the German Generals!





the fighting and give time to write a peace treaty. The Great War was over.
